BRIEF HISTORY

The La Consolacion University Philippines College of Medicine was established in June 2017 after granted a permit to operate by CHED. Headed by Dean Ma, Cristina E, Zulueta, faculty from different established medical schools from Manila taught the pioneer batch for academic year 2017-2018. Upon its establishment, facilities and laboratory equipment have been ensured to be at par with other established medical schools. It is also a member of the Association of Philippine Medical Colleges Foundation Incorporated. With a strong collaborative support from the local government, students have their clinical exposure at Bulacan Medical Center, a Department of Health Level III Accredited Hospital Facility. Consistent on its offering of quality medical education, the College is now on its fourth year with a stronger faculty roster who are highly qualified and known with their respective fields of specialties. The curriculum follows that of the Outcome Based Education Strategy as mandated by CHED. While ensuring clinical competence and unique to the curriculum of LCUP COM, the students are developed holistically to be "doctors with a heart" on a course called: Applied Augustinian Philosophy in the Practice of Medicine. An LCUP COM graduate is envisioned to be competent, empathetic, holistically trained to manage patients both in the community and hospital setting rendering humble and generous service.

Close proximity and easy accessibility

The Philippines is just around 6 to 8 hours flight from India. Philippines is well connected with countries like India, Singapore, Malaysia, United States, Australia through both air routes and sea routes. There are daily flights to Philippines from various cities of India like Hyderabad, Chennai, New Delhi, Mumbai and Kolkota.

The Medical graduation granted is recognized by the Medical Council of India. The name which is listed in Schedule –III (as per section 13) Part II of Indian Medical Council.

Strictly allopathic form of medical teaching

Teaching approach is science-based modern medicine.

Excellent clinical exposure and hands-on practice

The students of Philippine Universities have handful clinical exposure during their clerkship in 3800 bedded own hospitals for their clinical rotations in the third and fourth year of their studies.



Excellent Faculty and facilities

The facilities provided by the College of Medicine are comparable to the best in the Philippines and even globally. Its information technology infrastructure and laboratory equipment prepare its students for global competitiveness. The university has 300 Faculty members drawn from a wide range of medical specialties and the total student population of all four years of students is usually around 800. So the student faculty ratio is low which is ideal for student's success. Its faculty and staff are dedicated and highly competent. The laboratories and library of the university are well equipped with ultra modern equipment and books respectively. The anatomy lab of the school has handful cadavers (dead bodies) and the student cadaver ratio is only around 1:10.

Worldwide Recognition

This institution and the medical qualification offered (M.D. – Doctor of Medicine) is recognized by WHO (World Health Organization), ECFMG (Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates), FAIMER (Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research) and National Medical Commission(NMC).

Proven track record of satisfied students in Philippines

Some of the students who have already graduated from Philippine Colleges and these doctors are well recognized by various hospitals and clinics all over India. These FMG's graduated from Philippines are more successfully working in corporate hospitals and private clinics all over India compared with those graduated from other nations like China, Russia.

High MCI pass percentage

The MCI pass percentage of FMG's from Philippines is usually 5-7 times higher than those from other nations. In the MCI screening test conducted in the recent years the passing percentage of FMG's from Philippine universities in the first attempt is 53% whereas national passing rate is only 9%.

Excellent Hostel Facilities


On campus accommodation is provided for both boys and girls.

- 2. What is the degree offered?
- Doctor of Medicine (MD).
- 3. How is it different from MBBS?
- MBBS and MD are both primary medical qualifications. The degrees are equal(ECFMG list of degrees recognized from different countries). MBBS is British system of Education where as MD is American system of Education.
- 4. What is the total duration of the course?
- · Approximately five years and six months
- 5. What is the eligibility for admission?
- 12th Grade with minimum 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects and pass in English.
- NEETQualified
- Can I do my Internship in India?
 Yes. After completion of screening test and procuring Provisional Registration of MCI.

- 7. Can I practice in India on my return?
 - Yes, after successful completion of Screening Test and Internship, the student is eligible to register with MCI (NMC) and State Medical Councils and can practice in India.
- 8. Are there any extra fees for the Screening Test?
- The nominal exam fee is to be borne by the student.
- 9. What happens if the student fails to clear the Screening test?
- A student can appear number of times for the Screening Test. However, generally students who pass the MD degree of an American System of Education is expected to clear this exam in the first attempt.
- 10. Can I get a job in Govt. hospitals or allied Medical institutions in India?
- Yes, upon registration with MCI/State Councils, the student is eligible for any Government job.
- 11. Can a student avail educational loan? If Yes, what are the Procedures?
- Yes, education loans are available from all the nationalized and scheduled banks. The student has to apply directly to the bank at the place of permanent residence. SPUP offices will assist student in procuring the loan by providing all necessary documents required from the University.
- 12. Can a student take USMLE?
- Yes. Graduates from all associates Universities are eligible for appearing in USMLE.
- 13. Are there hostel facilities available in these Universities?
- · Yes, hostel facilities are available for both boys and girls and Indian food.

 Upon receipt of Original Receipts and Official Letter of Acceptance from the university, submit all ORIGINAL documents for Ministry of External Affairs Authentication.
- Step 5: Visa Processing
